Western Cheshire PCT Small Grants Fund Guidance Notes

Who can apply

To apply for a grant the group must:

- Be a group local within the district of Chester, or delivering a project in Chester
- Be a voluntary or community group or registered Charity
- Have a set of accounts or as a minimum a group bank account.

Grant Criteria

To be considered for a grant, you will need to show how you will meet at least **one** of the following aims:

- Contributes to improving health and well-being
- > Helps tackle levels of disadvantage in the locality
- Assists in reducing barriers to social inclusion
- Responds to local needs and priorities
- > Improves the local community, or community of interest

Restrictions

- Grants will not be given for expenditure already made.
- Applications can only be made for up to £500 for projects and initiatives

Application Process

- 1. Applications can be made at **anytime** between April 2009 March 2010
- 2. Applications must be made on the standard application form.
- 3. Application forms are to be submitted to Chester Voluntary Action.
- 4. Applicants must provide a copy of **both** your constitution, terms of reference or rules, and a recent bank statement or income and expenditure sheet (see form)
- 5. Groups can apply more than once in a financial year (April to March) but priority will be given to new applications. Subsquent requests must be for different projects/initiatives.

- 6. Grants will be awarded based on the recommendations of an independent grant panel.
- 7. Applicants will be told if they are successful or not within 15 working days of submission.
- 8. Payment will be made via cheque or to settle an invoice received from a third party.
- 9. Written feedback will be required on how the grant money was spent.
